

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Gibbon that the property tax request for the current year be a different amount than the property tax request for the prior year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the City of Gibbon, by a majority vote, resolves that:

1. The 2018-2019 property tax request be set at:

General: \$325,621.94 (.35)

Bond: \$148,855.86 (.16)

2. A copy of this Resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk prior to October 13.2018.
