City Meetings:

Planning Commission is held on the second Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall for all newly filed building permits.

Mayor and Council Meeting is held on the third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall and is open to the public. We have a volunteer rescue and fire department which there is a high and low pitched whistle that notifies the public there is an emergency in the area and to watch for the right of way for the emergency vehicles.

Gibbon has a whistle that sounds at 7:00 a.m., 12:00 (noon), 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. We also have the civil defense whistle which sounds in the event of inclement weather. This notifies citizens to take cover during tornatic weather. This whistle is a long drawn out sound and is tested the first Thursday of every month at 5:30 p.m. Gibbon hosts a citywide cleanup day yearly. At this time the residents may take household items with the exception of tires, batteries and paint to the City's Yard Waste Collection Area. City Hall will post notices on the dates they will be hosting the cleanup days. Regular garbage pick-up is on Wednesday. To ensure your toter gets dumped we advise you to pull it to the curb on Tuesday night.

Gibbon Public Library: Hours for the library are Monday through Friday 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturday 11:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m.

Gibbon is very proud of its parks. The City Swimming Pool opens Memorial weekend for the season. **Davis Park** located on the north side of town has tennis courts, sand volleyball courts, picnic areas, baseball field, children's playground equipment and a 9 hole Frisbee golf course. **Pioneer Park** located downtown has children's playground and a picnic gazebo. **Rosen Park** located on the southwest edge of town is the site for soccer games, city pool and has a walking track. **Legion Fields** at the south edge of town and the field at **Davis Park** will be the areas for baseball and softball games during the summer. Both ballparks have concessions available during games. All City Parks close at dusk.

City Yard Waste Collection Area: This area is open to Gibbon residents on Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Residents can drop off leaves, grass clippings, garden waste, branches and small limbs. For access to the Landfill after regular hours a resident can purchase a gate card for \$25.00 at City Hall.

Grass Clippings: The garbage company will not dump any garbage toters that contain yard waste. There is an ordinance against leaving clippings in the street after mowing. Property owners are responsible for mowing alleyways abutting their property and between the street and sidewalks. Residents must also keep their sidewalks clear of debris.

Snow must be removed from the sidewalks 24 hours following a snowfall. During a snow emergency vehicles on the dedicated snow routes must be removed from the street so crews may remove snow. Violators may be towed and ticketed. Please be aware of declared snow emergencies this season.

Building Permits: Residents must get a building permit which must be approved by the Planning Commission and City Council before doing any building (house addition, storage shed, garage, decks, carport, fence, etc.) within the city. Please call City Hall for further explanation or look on the City's website under zoning regulations.

City Utilities: For payment convenience customers may use the City's drop box for 24-hour payment service. It is located to the left of the front door at City Hall. You can pay online on the website, however there is a 2.45% fee. We also offer automatic withdrawal which comes out of your bank account on the 15th of the month. Utility bills are due on the 1st of the month and are considered delinquent on the 20th of the month. The City will assess a late payment fee of \$15.00 for payments received after the 20th of the month.
